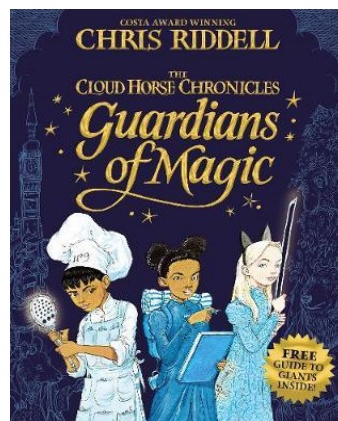
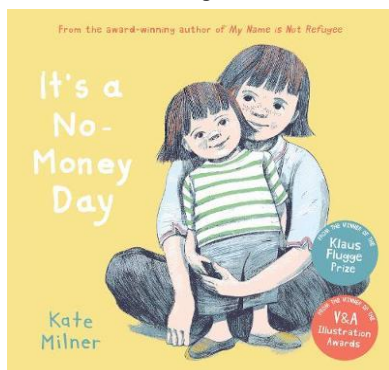
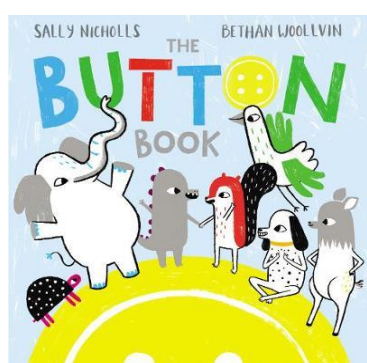

'The Button Book' by Sally Nicholls & Bethan Woolvin: Here's a button. I wonder what happens when you press it? This is a remarkable adventure powered purely by imagination – where the sounds, songs and play are completely up to you and whoever you're sharing the book with. Published: 3/10/19 & for age 3+.

'It's a No-Money Day' by Kate Milner: Milner won the 2018 Klaus Flugge Award for most promising newcomer to children's book illustration. Mum works really hard and watches every penny – but today is a no-money day. Her little girl (the narrator) takes great pleasure in simple, free activities – and doesn't feel mum's humiliation in having to visit the food bank. Ideal for encouraging discussion and fostering empathy. Published: 15/10/19 and is for age 3+.

'Guardians of Magic' by Chris Riddell: Book one of The Cloud Horse Chronicles is a stunningly illustrated magical quest in which three ordinary children, with extraordinary gifts, come together to defeat the enemies who threaten the mysterious cloud horses. This was published on 19/9/19 and is for age 9+.
