Symptoms of Covid 19

- New continuous cough and / or
- High temperature and / or
- A loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell

How to help stop COVID-19 from spreading

- Wash your hands with soap and water often—do this for at least 20 seconds
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze
- Put tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
