- No 1:1 meetings should take place, groups only.
- Staff and children must wear suitable clothing, as should anyone else in the household.
- Any computers used should be in appropriate areas that are easily supervised, for example, not in bedrooms.
- Language must be appropriate and we request that any adults or children nearby are mindful of this.
- Don't take screenshots or screen recordings of virtual classrooms.

To promote safety, meetings will be password protected and participants will need an invitation to attend. Therefore, you will need the details emailed to you to enter the meeting. These will be in the form of a meeting ID and password.
