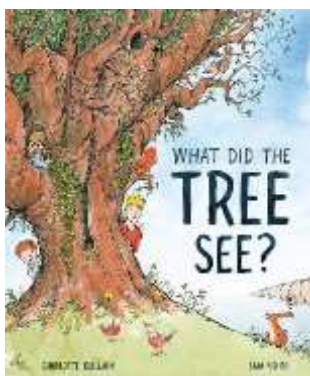

'Jeremy Worried About the Wind': A book for age 3+ from 'Wigglesbottom Primary' author Pamela Butchart. Jeremy is a worrier. He worries about odd socks, spotty bananas, evil squirrels, burnt toast, dinosaurs.....and most of all – the wind.

Published on September 3rd and ideal for PSHE lessons.

'Interview with a Tiger & Other Clawed Beasts Too': For age 5+, this quirky information book lets 'celeb' animals speak for themselves. Using his amazing 'tranimalator', author Andy Seed interviews a horde of scary animals (inc: a tiger, a honey badger and a snow leopard) and translates their sounds into words. Illustrated by Nick East and published on 17th September.



'What Did The Tree See?': The simple rhyming text (by Charlotte Guillian) in this book is matched by carefully detailed illustrations (by Sam Usher). It tells the story of how a modern place will have been created over the centuries and cleverly records the history of the place from the perspective of an oak tree.
