Loving and caring school...

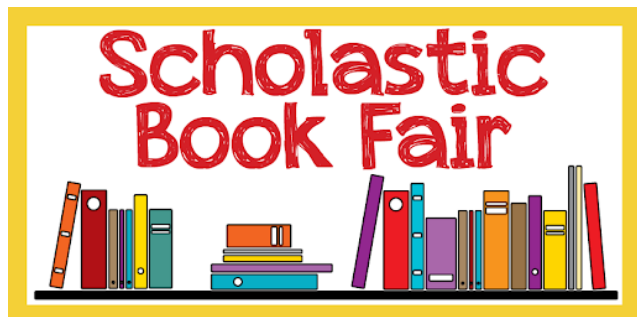
Very well behaved...

Excellent manners...

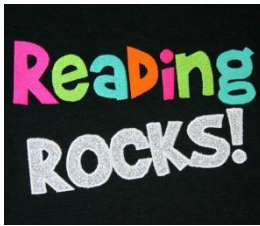

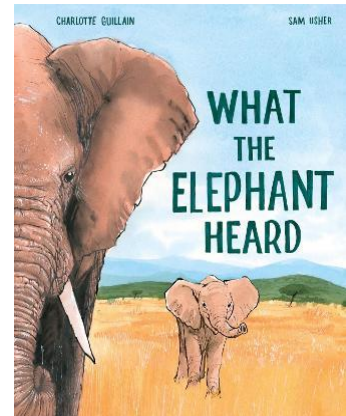
