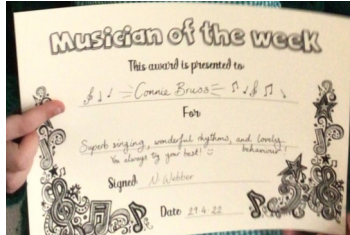
Random Acts of KINDNESS
