

As you read this newsletter, our Year Five and Six Drama and Theatre Club children will be wending their way to the brand-new Shakespeare North Playhouse. For the children's first live theatre experience of the new school year, they will be seeing **As You Write It**.

A collaboration between the Shakespeare North Playhouse and BBC's The One Show, **As You Write It** is the result of a writing competition for 7 to 16 year-olds. The evening will comprise three acts:
