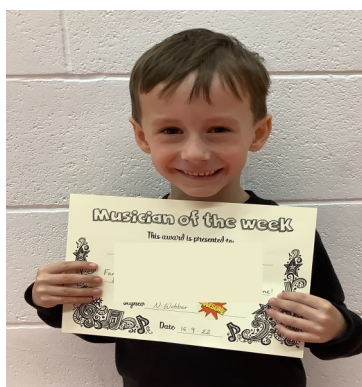
# Star of the Week

Well done, Archie!



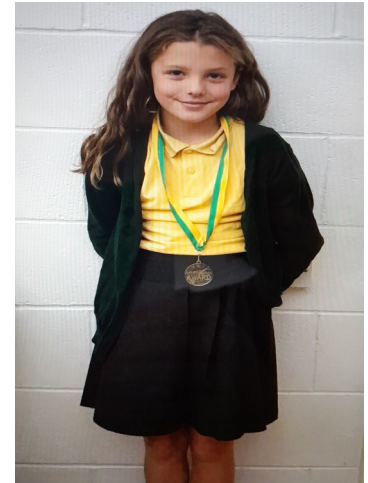
