This Act makes clear that we may not grant leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. Furthermore, we are required to inform the School Attendance Service of any periods of unauthorised absence from school. The School Attendance Service will then consider if any legal action or the issue of a Penalty Notice is appropriate.

Random Acts of


