incisors	Teeth for snipping and cutting.	
canines	Teeth from ripping and tearing.	
molars	Teeth for chewing and grinding.	
salivary gland	Where saliva is produced.	
oesophagus	Food pipe that joins the mouth to the stomach.	
small intestine	Where nutrients are absorbed.	
large intestine	Where water is absorbed.	
stomach	Where food is crushed and mixed with acid.	
liver	Where digestive juices (bile) is produced.	
rectum	Where waste is stored.	
anus	Where solid waste leaves the body.
