Apologies for the delayed newsletter. We have been awaiting some exciting information and I am pleased to confirm that the results are in. Malvern is officially Top of the Rocks!

On Friday, we celebrated Number Day 2023 with all children invited to 'Dress up for Digits'. Number Day is celebrated throughout the UK by NSPPC to raise awareness and funds for a fantastic cause. To promote the day, all schools were invited to compete in an NSPCC Rocks Times Tables competition and - once again - our amazing children proved just how talented they are! Nearly 3000 primary and secondary schools took part and I am delighted to report that Malvern finished in first place nationally in all categories.

As a school, we answered the most multiplication and division calculations correctly - amassing a staggering 523,464 correct answers! We also finished with the highest overall school average score and ended with an astonishing six classes finishing in the top seven classes across the country.

A special mention to 6IP who, out of just over 17,000 classes nationally, finished in first place. At the time of writing, the individual pupil results have not been finalised but I anticipate many Malvern pupils will have achieved exceptionally well. The children at Malvern never fail to amaze me with their enthusiasm and effort but this week's outstanding achievements have blown me away.
