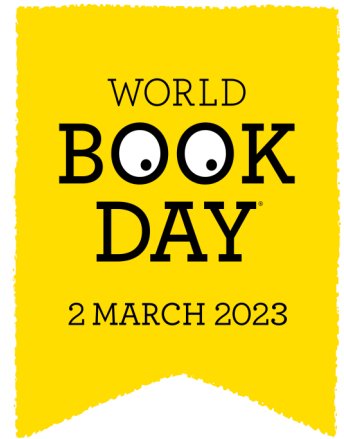

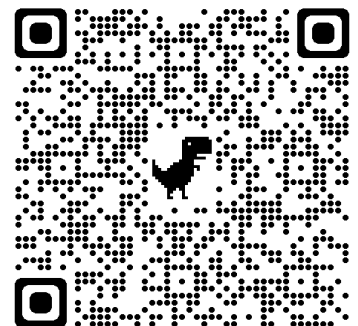
## Book Fair
