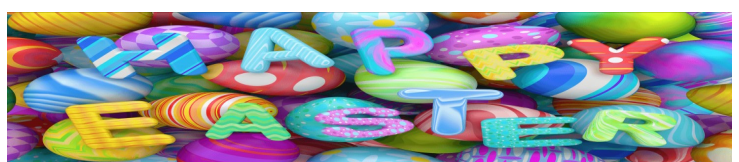


## Easter Events

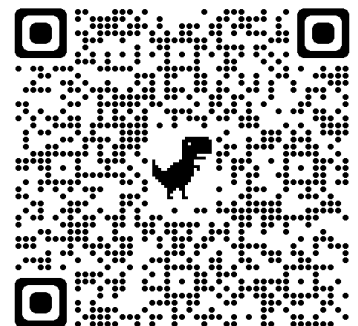
## Book Fair
