LEGO Build Challenge

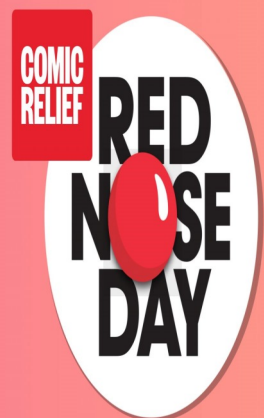
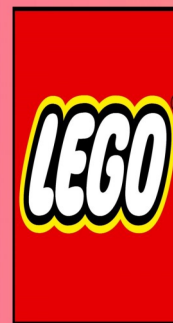
