




How Malvern Primary School received £4,516 per pupil






How Malvern Primary School spent £4,287 per pupil

In particular, Malvern Primary School spends noticeably more on premises total and supplies and services total, and noticeably less on staff total and cost of finance total.





Community Grants as a Percentage of Total Funds





Targeted Grants as a Percentage of Total Funds








Community Focused School Facilities

Community Focused School Facilities Income as a Percentage of Total Funds





Income from Facilities and Services as a Percentage of Total Funds





Income from Catering as a Percentage of Total Funds




Income from Donations as a Percentage of Total Funds



Income from Contributions to Visits as a Percentage of Total Funds








Receipts from Supply Teacher Insurance Claims

Receipts from Supply Teacher Insurance Claims as a Percentage of Total Funds



Spend on Education Support Staff as a Percentage of Total Spend







Spend on Administrative and Clerical Staff as a Percentage of Total Spend





Spend on Other Staff Costs as a Percentage of Total Spend



Cleaning and Caretaking as a Percentage of Total Spend







Maintenance and Improvement as a Percentage of Total Spend



Spend on Water and Sewerage as a Percentage of Total Spend





Spend on Rates as a Percentage of Total Spend



Spend on Other Insurance Premiums as a Percentage of Total Spend





Spend on Catering Expenditure as a Percentage of Total Spend





Spend on Administrative Supplies as a Percentage of Total Spend





Spend on Educational Supplies as a Percentage of Total Spend






Educational supplies accounted for 4.49% of total expenditure at Malvern Primary School last year. This puts the school in the highest 37% of similar schools, the lowest 48% in Knowsley, and the highest 31% of primary school nationally.

Last year, Malvern Primary School spent £90,450 or £193 per pupil on educational supplies. This is an increase of 23% from 2019/2020 and a decrease of 12% from 2018/2019.



Spend on Bought-in Professional Services as a Percentage of Total Spend






