### Holiday Requests During Term Time

We have received many requests for leave passed into the school office over recent weeks and we need to remind parents that schools are only allowed to authorise leave for children when there are exceptional circumstances.

Such exceptional circumstances include:

- Allowing a pupil to return to their country of origin for family, religious or cultural reasons
- Unavoidable work commitments e.g. parent/carer has inflexible leave allocation and this has been confirmed by their employer
- There is a family circumstance/ event which cannot be arranged within the dedicated school holiday time
- Leave of absence connected to children of service personnel

If your request for absence does not fall into one of the above categories, it is very unlikely your request will be granted. We would also like to remind parents that we may need to request further evidence to authorise an absence. Furthermore, if an absence is authorised this may impact your child's overall attendance figure.

Our school library is open from 8.00am each morning. Accompanied by an adult, children are welcome to come and have a read and browse the shelves. Children (and adults) may borrow books during this time and tea, coffee and hot chocolate are available for adults.
