At Malvern, we have worked exceptionally hard to create a vibrant and inclusive environment that extends beyond the school day. We are delighted to announce that our long-standing ambition of becoming a Community Sports Hub is now becoming a reality.

As many of you will be aware, we have a long established relationship with Unite Sports & Leisure who provide daily after school clubs and holiday provision throughout the year. Unite Sports and Leisure offer a perfect balance of fun and educational activities, ensuring that children have a memorable and enjoyable time during the holidays.

We are also very fortunate to work in partnership with Dance Depot who provide weekly dance lessons every Thursday from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM. These engaging sessions help children express their creativity, improve their coordination and build confidence through the art of dance.

In addition, over recent months we have developed a great relationship with South Liverpool Community Coaching. SLCC now offer weekly football sessions every Saturday morning at Malvern from 9.00- 11.00am and it has been wonderful to see so many of our children taking up the opportunity to develop their football skills, enhance their teamwork skills and have fun on the pitch.

Polite Reminder

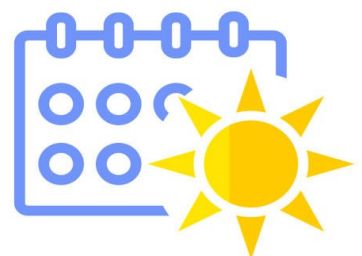
