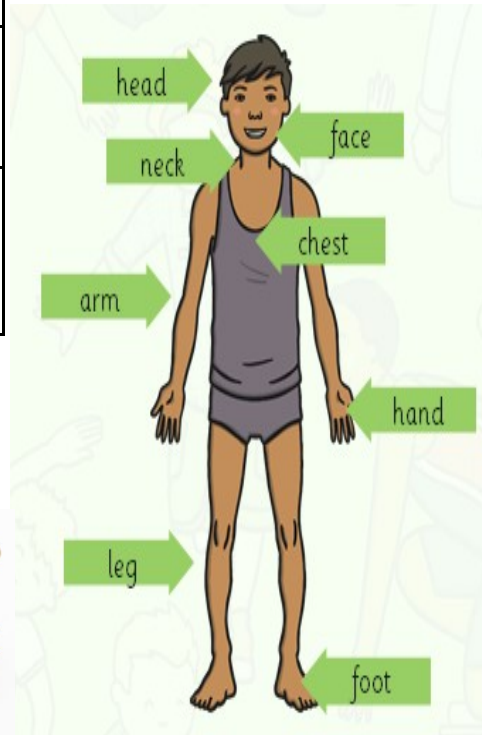
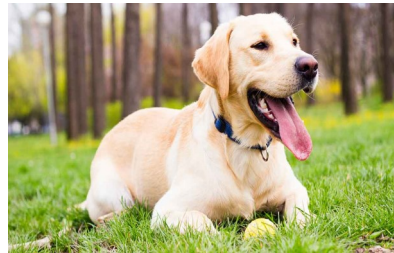


Paws, Claws & Whiskers

Science

What are the 5 senses?	The 5 senses are sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch.
What body parts are used for each sense?	Sight— eyes, hearing—ears, smell—nose, taste—tongue and touch—hands.
What animals are mammals?	Examples of mammals are cats, dogs and sheep. Humans are also mammals.
What animals are reptiles?	Examples of reptiles are snakes, lizards, turtles and crocodiles.
What animals are amphibians?	Examples of amphibians are frogs, toads, salamanders and newts.
What animals use camouflage?	Some animals that use camouflage are chameleons, tree frogs, leopards and lizards.



Music

What is pulse in music?	In music the pulse means a steady beat.
What are untuned instruments?	An untuned instrument is an instrument that is not able to produce a certain pitch.
What is the tempo in music?	The tempo is the speed at which a piece of music is played.



VOCABULARY

mammal	A mammal is an animal that breathes air, has a backbone and grows hair/fur at some point during its life. Humans are also mammals.
reptile	A reptile is a cold-blooded animal that breathes air and their body is covered in scales.
amphibian	An amphibian is a cold-blooded animal that spends some of its life in water and some of it on land.
camouflage	Something that animals use to blend in with their surroundings.
