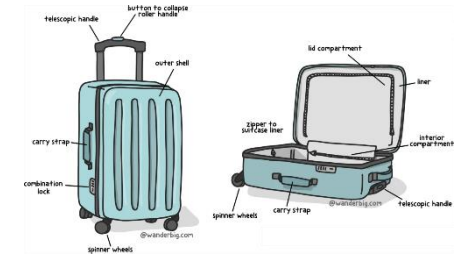
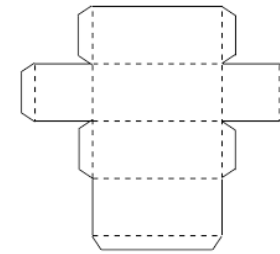


We'll Meet Again

Key Dates – Timeline of Events	
1 st Sept 1939	The Germans invade Poland. World War 2 begins. Children are evacuated to the countryside.
3 rd Sept 1939	France and Great Britain declare war on Germany.
10 th May 1940	Winston Churchill becomes Prime Minister of Great Britain.
10 th July 1940	Germany launches air attacks on Britain (Battle of Britain.)
7 th Sep 1940	The Blitz begins. (Ends 10 th May 1941).
30 th April 1945	Hitler commits suicide - he knows Germany has lost the war.
7 th May, 1945	Germany surrenders to the Allies.
8 th May, 1945	Britain celebrates V.E Day

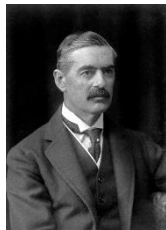
Adolf Hitler – rose to power as the leader of the Nazi Party

Key Vocabulary	
Air raid	An attack by enemy planes dropping bombs.
Air raid shelter	Made from steel panels in gardens for protection during air raids.
Allies	Countries who fought against the Axis including Britain, France and the Soviet Union.
Axis	Germany, Italy, Japan and others who were the enemy and fought against the Allies.
Blitzkrieg	Intense and sudden bombings on major British cities from the Germans.
Evacuee	Someone who was moved from a danger area to a safer place, usually countryside.
Gas masks	Face mask to protect against poison gas attacks.
