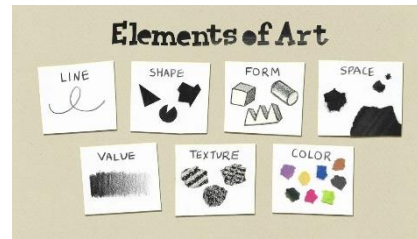


# Mayan Mysteries

Art Vocabulary	
<b>Portrait</b>	a painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person,
<b>Portraiture</b>	the art of painting or taking portraits.
<b>Colourist</b>	an artist or designer who uses colour in a special or skilful way.
<b>Symbolism</b>	an artistic and poetic movement or style using symbolic images
<b>Aquarelle</b>	the technique of painting with thin, transparent watercolours.



Geography Vocabulary	
<b>Eco system</b>	a community of interacting organisms and their environment.
<b>Savannah</b>	a grassy plain in tropical and subtropical regions, with few trees.
<b>Climate</b>	long-term pattern of weather in an area
<b>Biome</b>	a large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna
<b>Elevation</b>	height above a given level, especially sea level.
<b>Urbanisation</b>	shift from rural to urban areas,
<b>Vegetation belt</b>	regions of the world that are home to certain plant species determined by the climate

<b>Nation</b>	a large body of people united by common descent, history, culture, or language,

<b>Manipulate</b>	Handle or control in a skilful manner
<b>Applique</b>	decorate with pieces of fabric to form pictures or patterns.
<b>Seam</b>	a line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together
<b>Form</b>	visible shape or configuration of something.
<b>Weave</b>	form by interlacing long threads passing in one direction with others at a right angle to them.
<b>Loom</b>	apparatus for making fabric by weaving yarn or thread
