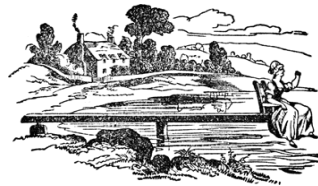

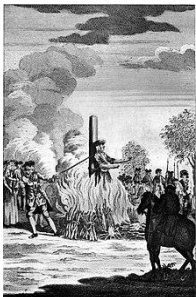

Tudor Glossary	Definition
Monarch	Someone who reigns over a kingdom
Treason	Betrayal of the King. The class reading book.

Traitor	A person who betrays someone
Heir	A person who inherits things from another person
