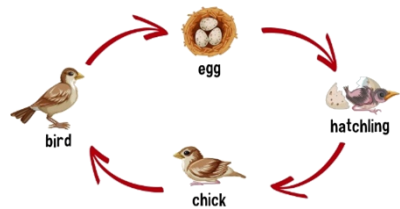


When I Grow Up

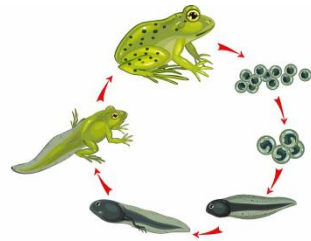
What are the different stages in a human's lifecycle? How do we change as we get older?	Birth → toddler → infant → teenager → puberty → young adult → middle age → old age → death

Science Glossary	Definition
Puberty	The time when your body begins to change and develop as you turn from a child into an adult.
Gestation	The amount of time that a mammal carries her offspring before giving birth.
Foetus	An unborn or unhatched vertebrate in the latter stages of development.
Metamorphosis	the process of transformation from an immature form to an adult form in two or more distinct stages.
Weaned	To take an infant or other young mammal of food other than its mother's milk.

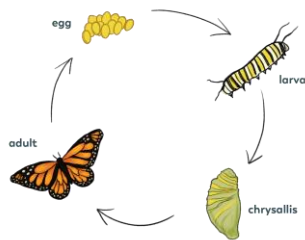
Bird Life Cycle



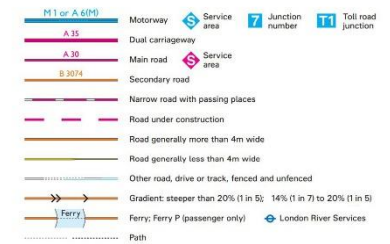
Amphibian Life Cycle



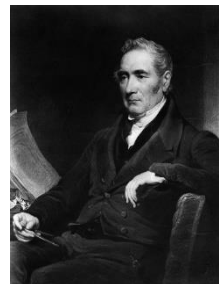
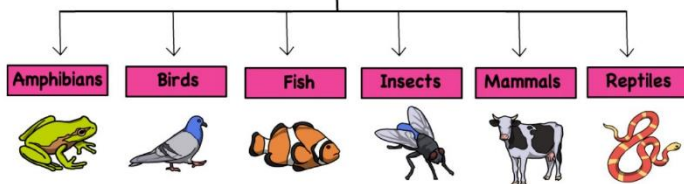
Insect Life Cycle
