Entry Task:

The Big Question

Which visual elements are important in the artwork of Piet Mondrian?

Sketchbook Study: How did Mondrian use line in his artwork?
How many different ways can I make a line? How many different ways can I make a straight line?
Can I use graphical modelling software to create a straight line?
Can I use line to create a repeating pattern?

What is a tint?

Can I create 5 tints of a primary hue?

Using what I have learnt about line, primary colour, pattern, and shape, can I create my own geometric abstract art inspired by Piet Mondrian?

What is an organic shape?
How many geometric shapes can I find in the work of Piet Mondrian? How many organic shapes?
