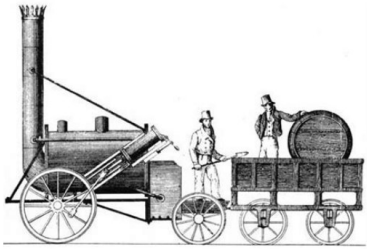
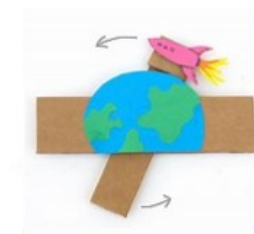

History

How have toys changed over the years?	The materials that toys are made from have changed. Toys are now much safer and have strict checks before being used.
How has train design progressed over time?	Years ago trains were mostly steam trains. Now trains are powered by a mix of electricity and diesel.
What were the Rainhill Trials?	The Rainhill trials were a competition between locomotives to see which would be the best for the then nearly finished Manchester to Liverpool railway.
Who was George Stephenson?	George Stephenson was an English engineer and inventor of the railroad locomotive.
What was Stephenson's Rocket?	Stephenson's Rocket was the first modern steam locomotive. It was built for and won the Rainhill Trials in 1829.

What is a pop-up card?	A pop-up card is a card where something pops up on the inside when you open it.
What are sliders?	A slider is a bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line.
What are levers?	A lever is a bar that moves around a pivot. Simple sliders and levers can be used to create movement in a picture.
