
What are the 5 senses?	The 5 senses are sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch.
What body parts are used for each sense?	Sight— eyes, hear- ing—ears, smell— nose, taste—tongue and touch—hands.
What animals are mammals?	Examples of mam- mals are cats, dogs and sheep. Hu- mans are also mammals.
What animals are reptiles?	Examples of reptiles are snakes, lizards, turtles and crocodiles.
What animals are amphibi-ans?	Examples of am- phibians are frogs, toads, salaman- ders and newts.
What animals use camou-flage?	Some animals that use camouflage are chameleons, tree frogs, leopards and lizards.
