Who is Laurel True?

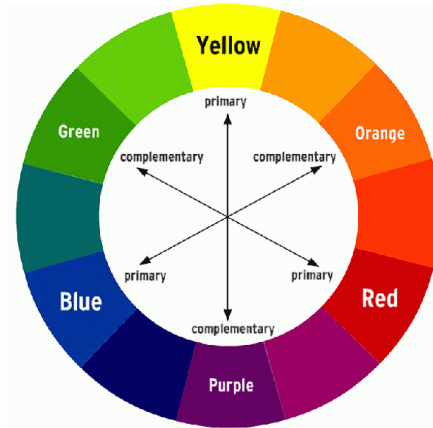
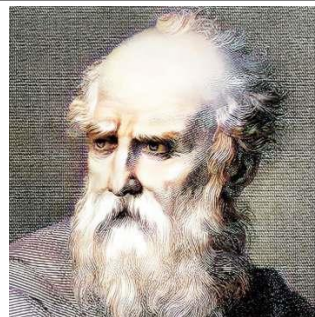
Laurel True is an American artist, architectural artist, muralist and mosaic artist. She is the founder of one of the first formal mosaic institutes in America.

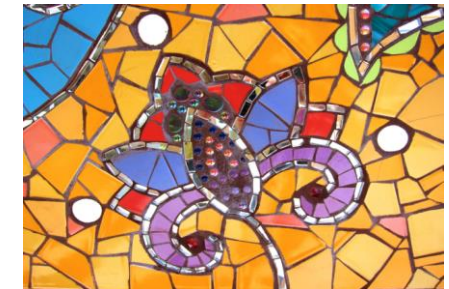
