What is Fauvism?	Favism is the name given to an art movement that took place in the early 20 <sup>th</sup> century. It is known for its strong colours and brushwork.
Who is Henri Matisse?	Henri Matisse was a French painter who was the leader of the Fauvist movement.
Who is Andre Derain?	Andre Derain was a French painter who was co-founder of Fauvism with Henri Matisse.
How did Matisse and Derain contribute to the Fauvist movement?	They introduced unnaturalistic colour and vivid brushstrokes into their paintings in the summer of 1905.
What is positive and negative space?	Positive space refers to the subjects or areas of interest in a piece of artwork. Negative space is the background or the area that surrounds the subject.
What is texture?	Tactile texture means how something feels to the touch. Visual texture refers to the visual impression that textures produce to the observer.


