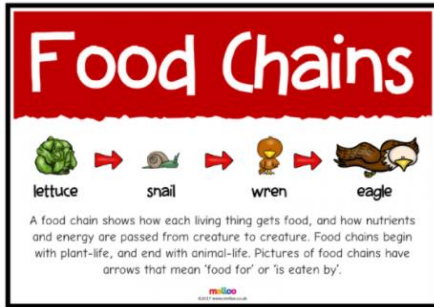
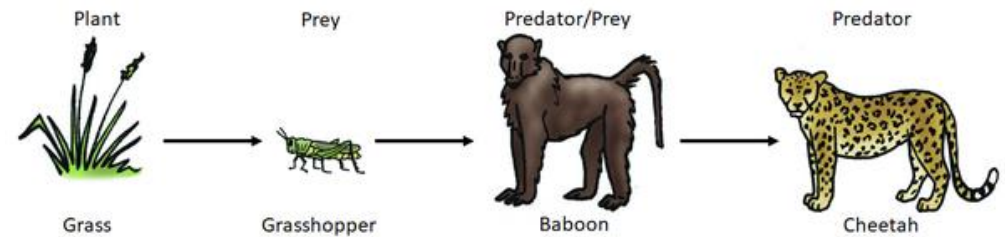


Producers, Predators and Prey

| Word | Meaning |
|------------|--|
| Producers | Something that produced its own food such as a plant. |
| Predators | An animal that hunts and kills another animal for food. |
| Prey | An animal that is hunted and killed as food by another animal. |
| Food chain | A chain that shows us how plants and animals in a habitat rely on each other for food. |
| Carnivore | Meat eater. An animal whose energy comes solely from eating meat. |
| Herbivore | Plant eater. An animal whose energy comes solely from eating plants. |

Important Facts

- Predators are usually carnivores.
- Predators are found at the top of the food chain.
- Prey animals have developed ways to try to stop being eaten such as camouflage.
- A food chain always starts with a producer.
