Seasons



<u>Word</u>	<u>Meaning</u>
Autumn	Season between summer and winter. The temperature gets colder and the leaves start to fall down.
Freezing	When a liquid turns into a solid.
Melting	When a solid turns into a liquid.
Rainbow	A multicoloured arc formed by the reflections of the sun's rays in raindrops.
Reflection	The return of light or sound waves from a surface.
Season	One of four periods of the year.
Spring	Season between winter and summer. Flowers start to grow, baby animals are born and the temperature gets warmer.
Summer	Season between spring and autumn. The days are longer and hotter.
Temperature	A measurement of how hot or cold something is.
Winter	Season between autumn and spring. Days are short and the weather is usually cold.

Important Facts

Some trees change their appearance during the seasons.
 The amount of daylight we get differs from season to season.
