Big Question:

How do human beings change as they grow?

Assessment Outcomes:

I can explain that human beings have a life cycle and change as they age. I can challenge stereotypical viewpoints and understand that it is ok to change my thinking.

I can revisit and consolidate the physical differences between boys and girls, use the correct names for parts of the body. I understand that appreciate that some parts of my body are considered private.
