Dear Malvern Families

I have been informed by Knowsley Council that essential traffic calming works are scheduled to take place in the Swanside area until the 5th December 2025. These works will affect several local roads including Greystone Road, Regent Avenue, Norbreck Avenue, Hilary Avenue, Westfield Avenue, Willoughby Avenue and both Penrose Avenue East and West.

The works will be carried out in phases which means that not all roads will be closed at the same time. Access will be maintained where possible and the closures will be managed onsite by the Highways and Capital Delivery Team.

Families who travel to school by car will need to allow extra time for their journey during this period. I would also like to encourage as many families as possible to continue walking, cycling or scooting to school. These active travel choices reduce congestion around the school site and help to keep everyone safe.

Learning Review Meetings



Every player represented Malvern brilliantly, showing great sportsmanship and determination throughout the tournament. Well done to all involved - we are very proud of you.




Healthy Packed Lunches
